

ANA TOWERS SURFERS PARADISE QLD

On a site seen as the gateway to a renewed city heart for Surfers Paradise and the wider Gold Coast, the ANA's towers will be a major urban landmark.

The two tower configuration—with the taller (69 levels) located in the south east corner and the shorter (55 levels) placed on the north west—will contain residential apartments, commercial office, entertainment, dining and retail components and strong civic and urban linking spaces.

A gently curved pedestrian corridor is the backbone of the planning with one tower sitting either side of this expression, echoing the striking sense of geometric form in the tower and podium design, while enhancing existing urban connections at street level.

Innovative façade and transition planes create distinctive, engaging spaces for the inhabitants and visitors to the development's street and podium levels. Above, the tower designs allow for 360° views of the Gold Coast's urban and natural context from efficient, substantially clear floorplates.

Designed for Raptis Group, the project is planned for completion in 2012.
