

LEEUWIN ESTATE WINERY MARGARET RIVER WA INTERIORS

The refurbishment of the winery restaurant at Leeuwin Estate has brought a contemporary quality to the dining and tasting spaces, and features materials that relate directly to the wine making process.

Designed by The Buchan Group in the mid-1980's, Leeuwin Estate Winery is famous for its award-winning wines. Recently refurbished, the Leeuwin Restaurant has a contemporary rustic aesthetic. The flexible dining area extends onto a verandah and, on the interior, links to a tasting room.

The curved fronted tasting bar incorporates stainless steel and recycled oak barrel staves, two of the most common materials used in winemaking. A coffered ceiling drum adds natural light and evening character.
